Summary:

Kevin McDonald is a sociologist whose new book "Struggles for Subjectivity" is based on three years of fieldwork with young people. They are aged between 15 and 25, all unemployed and of mixed ethnicity. Some are members of gangs, others are graffiti artists. McDonald explores their struggle for identity and the crises they face. Khaled Sabsabi is a hip-hop artist who works with young people at risk, using hip-hop as a voice for minority youth.
