Role is music to his ears

MISSION Australia's Miller Youth Centre has employed a specialist music program co-ordinator.

Khaled Sabsabi, who recently completed his fellowship for the Australian Council for the Arts, has taken up the role and will help young people to develop techniques of multimedia production.

He aims to help them fulfil their visions of excelling in music production.

"We will use the Miller studio to assemble sound, video, text and images to develop interactive media which is innovative and challenging," he said.

Mr Sabsabi, who studied for his fellowship overseas last year before taking up the new position, said the program would inspire local young people to future education and employment opportunities within these fields.

He said participants would be composing music for small ensembles or solo instruments, recording and editing projects, providing and managing sounds, video and original music for theatre productions.

He said they would also be studying basic live acoustics, planning and preparing for short film productions and internet publishing projects.
